

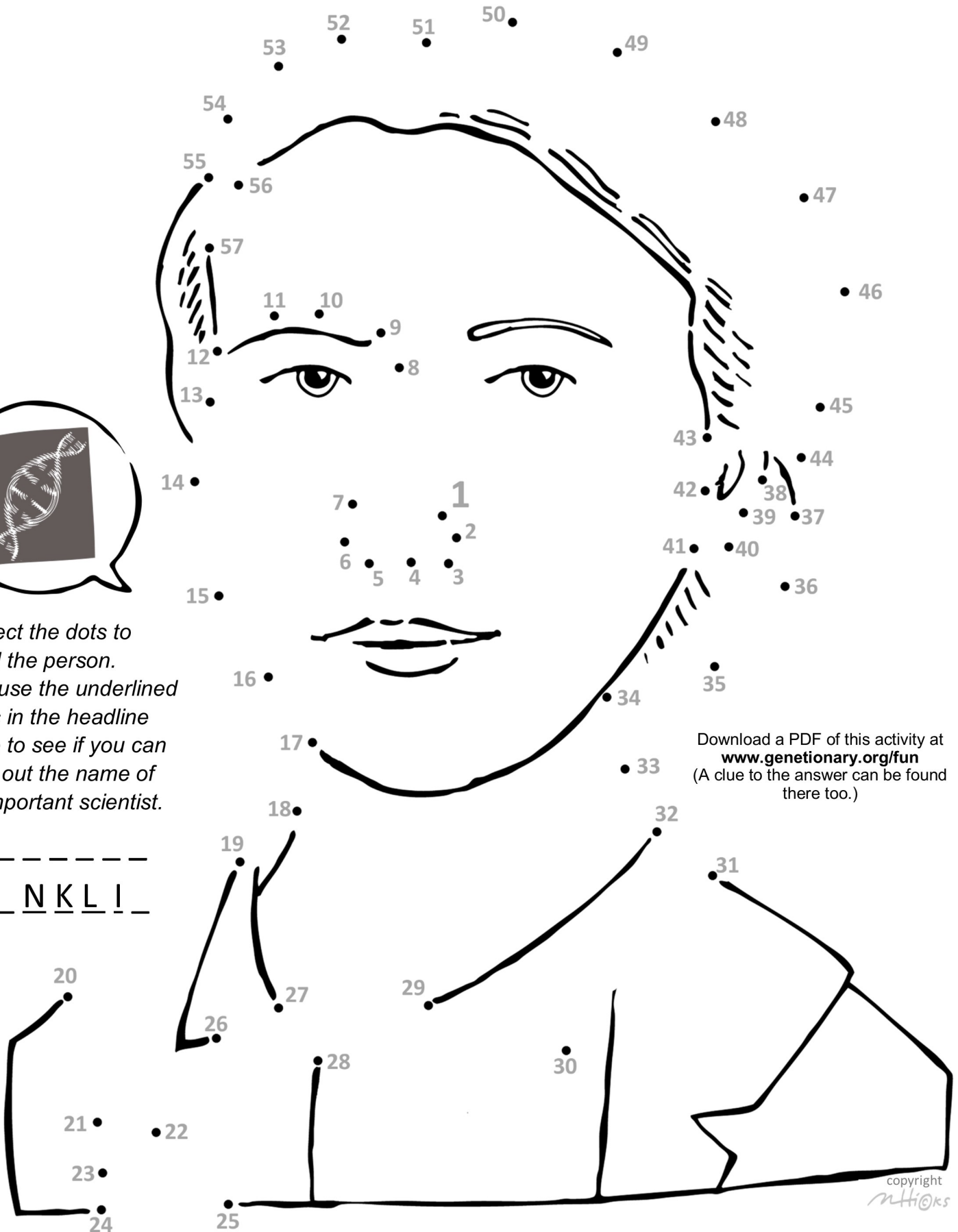
REVEALING THE SECRETS OF DNA
